DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Daniel Scott House is a two story stone house with a stucco exterior built about 1850 and located on the west side of Ady Road (Maryland Route 543) about 1/4 mile south of the Ady Road-Dublin Road intersection at Ady, Harford County, Maryland. The main elevation faces east.

The main facade has three bays with a center entry under a simple bracketed shed roof. A modern flagstone terrace surrounded by a low stone wall with a concrete coping fronts the facade. The gable ends have interior brick chimneys and the box cornice returns at each end. The rear of the house has a concrete block wing, undoubtedly added in the mid-20th century. Most windows are 6/6. The entire stucco and concrete block exterior and the stone wall around the terrace are painted a mustard yellow.

About 75 yards west of the house, across a small creek, is a frame barn with a stone foundation. It has mortise and tenon construction, vertical siding, and a slate roof. Immediately southeast of the barn is a concrete block shed with a gambrel metal roof, apparently a mid-20th century structure.



Martenet's Map of Harford County, 1878


