This cemetery has several small trees inside a rustic wire fence about 100' square, among graves marked by uncut and cut stones.

An undetermined number of stones about 1' to 2' high and from 8" to 14" across are set on end in an orderly row and appear to mark unnamed graves. About 28 to 34 marked graves are in its order and only a few can be clearly read; these are listed ~~under~~ below.
