At one time this village had a tavern, post office, saw mill, grist mill, forge, general store and hotel.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is two stories high and three bays by two. The house, on Mill Green Road, faces south.

The slate covered roof is gable flank and has a peaked gable in the center. A four pane arched window is situated in this peak. Two corbeled brick chimneys flank this peak on the roof's ridge line. The roof has wide eaves.

Windows are two lights over two. These have louvered shutters. The principle facade is in the center bay of the south facade. The door has a transom and sidelights.

A one story, hip roof porch extends along the entire south facade, as well as the east facade of this house. The porch has fairly plain, bracketed columns.

An addition on the northeast is two bays long and has a one story porch attached to its west facade.


