DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This quarry for green and white "marble" is a hole almost 300' square and several hundred feet deep, perpetually pumped of water, from which mines go out laterally in at least one location.

There are three or more "factory" buildings of wood where blocks of marble are sawn and polished.

The largest veins having been run out, smaller pieces are now crushed for decorative floorings.

Perhaps the most widely-known location is the colonnade around the fountain in Washington's National Gallery. Also found in the central Manhattan Post Office and Back Bay Station in Boston, according to Mr. Milo Williams.</p> <p style="font-size: 1.2em;">First quarries for road bed material, the marble underlay granite. Material crushed now for terrazzo flooring a two-man operation.</p>


