DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Louis Thomas House is a grouping of two two-story frame houses connected by a one-story shed addition located on the northeast side of Gibson Road near the intersection of Hoopes Road in the Sandy Hook area of Harford County, Maryland. The houses face southwest toward Gibson Road and are set back from the road about 100 feet.

The two main sections of the group are two stories each, the southern house being slightly more formally arranged. This house has a three-bay main elevation with a center entry and shed porch. The second story has window openings in the outer bays. The porch roof is supported by plain posts on a concrete block balustrade. A shed addition on the rear connects with the other house.

The northern house has a two-story, two-bay main elevation with a smaller extension in the space between the two houses. This extension connects with the southern house. In addition, a shed porch on the extension continues along a concrete walk to join the southern house.

The exterior of both houses is asbestos shingle siding and the roofs are composition. The foundation is stone on the southern house and concrete block on the northern house.

This little cluster of houses shelters three families in the Thomas clan. Formerly a farmer on the Hoopes place, Mr. Thomas took a job during World War II at Aberdeen. His daughter teaches, other family members work at Aberdeen and Edgewood. Still this is the best house they can afford.


