The village of Mill Green grew up around the once prosperous grist mill located on Broad Creek. The mill, built in 1827 by N.S. Bemis, to replace an older stone mill, remained in operation until approximately 1915.

Houses in the village of Mill Green reflect that era when the mill was known as Robert's Mill and owned and operated by Margaret Street (nee Roberts). Joseph Boyd is listed as her miller in the 1878 Business Directory.

At one time this village had a tavern, post office, saw mill, grist mill, forge, general store and hotel.

**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This frame house is located on the northern side of Mill Green Road in the village of Mill Green. The house is two and one half stories high, three bays by two. An addition on the northwest is two bays by one. The house faces south.

Windows are one light over one and have louvered shutters. The slate roof has a center gable with ornamental wood trim. A small, arched window is beneath this center gable. A corbeled brick chimney is located near the center of the roof.

The principle entrance is located in the center bay of the south facade. This has a transom and side lights. A two tier porch wraps around the south and west sides of the house. Columns are Roman Doric.


