Description of Property and Justification: *(Please attach map and photo)*  
 The property was most recently observed and photographed on January 17, 2003. Its condition appeared to be unchanged since the preparation of the Inventory Form for State Historic Sites Survey form in the library of the Maryland Historical Trust.  
 The property is described in the Maryland Historical Trust Inventory Form For State Historic Sites Survey prepared by Susan M. Deeney, Field Historian with the Historic District Commission, Report was not dated. The property is also described in, Maryland Historical Trust, Inventory Form For State Historic Sites Survey prepared by Jean S. Ewing, Maryland Historical Trust, on November 1979. Following is a brief summary of that property description, as modified by site observations made January 17, 2003.  
 From the description, the house is a two story, rectangular shaped, gabled slate roofed (east to west), rubble-stone house, which is three bays wide and two bays deep. A wood framed wing was added on the east end. An exterior cinder block chimney is on the west end and an interior chimney is on the east end. The main entrance is in the center bay on the south side. The west entrance has a wood portico/porch. Fenestration is 6/6 sash windows with granite lintels and 3/3 attic windows.

Records indicate that the house was in existence as early as 1858. A title search describes the property as early as 1796, although the house itself is not indicated.

In addition, the house was described in the undated MHT Inventory Form as being in good condition and altered. It was observed that this property appears unchanged from the description in the Inventory Form.

Nothing in the documentation reviewed for this Determination of Eligibility indicates that the Property is associated with events or persons that would qualify it for registration under Criteria A or B, the stone house and its wood-framed dependency represent an asset of local interest and importance and are considered to meet the qualifications of Criterion C for Design and Construction.



**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This rubblestone house is two stories high, three bays by two. A frame wing has been added to the east end. The house faces south.

The house has a gable flank roof covered with slate shingles. A brick chimney is located at the east inside end while a cinder block chimney is on the exterior west end. Windows are six lights over six through out except for attic windows of 3/3. Wide granite lintels are above all windows. The principal entrance is in the center bay of the south facade. The paneled door has a four light transom and sidelight with three panes of glass each. A flat roofed porch runs the length of the south side.

Stone house, two stories, 3 bays by 2 with a frame clapboard wrap at the east end. Facing south, the roof ridgeline runs east-west. There is a brick chimney in either end wall. Windows have 6 lights on 6 thruout, except for attic windows of 3 lights on 3.

The multi-colored fieldstone is cut on one face, set at random, except for wide granite lintels on all windows. The south door - originally the front entrance - has no steps at present.

Center-hall in plan, one room is on either side of the main house. The wrap consists of one room with a door in the east end wall leading to a lean-to, now a laundry.






