The Marvin Howard Log Building faces east, very close to the north side of Dorsey Mill Road. It is a three bay wide, one room deep, one story high, tin, gabled roof (running north-south) log building, resting on a stone foundation, with square brick chimney inset into the west side of the building's north wall, and a one story high, shed roofed, frame appendage, resting on a stone foundation, along the building's north wall.

Fenestration for the log house is rectangular and double-hung, holding six-over-six lights, with a square, four light, loft window resting in the south elevation.

It is noted on the 1878 Hopkin's Atlas as the residence of an E. Dorsey, and on the 1850 Martennet Map as M. Cook, S.M. and Clover M. Machine Shop.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Marvin Howard Log Building faces east, very close to the north side of Dorsey Mill Road. It is a three bay wide, one room deep, one story high, tin gabled roof (running north-south), log building, resting on a stone foundation, with square brick chimney inset into the west side of the building's north wall, and a one story high, shed roofed, frame appendage, resting on a stone foundation, along the buildings north wall.

Fenestration for the log house is rectangular and double-hung, holding six-over-six lights. A four light, square window rests in the south wall of the loft, formed by the gable, while a single six-over-six light, rectangular window rests in the center of its west wall. A six light, rectangular window also rests in the west wall of the shed roofed addition.

A central batten wood door on the east wall is flanked by rectangular six-over-six light windows and covered by a shed roofed open porch, supported by three square posts, which is enclosed on its north side.


