Facing south on the northeast corner of Baltimore and Fair Streets, this four bay wide, four bay deep shed roofed mill house is representative of ten duplexes constructed on the north and south sides of Baltimore Street between Commerce and Fair Streets in the first quarter of the twentieth century.

The south facade of this house has been considerably altered, its two front entrances becoming additional windows and the brick stoops on this elevation removed. The south windows are all decorated by shutters. A shed roofed covered rectangular entrance is located on Fair Street, facing west.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This mill house is located in the Savage Historic District on the north east corner of Fair and Baltimore Streets with an entrance in the rear of the building which faces south on Baltimore Street. It is a four bay wide, four bay deep, two story high, shed roofed brick (laid in English garden wall brick bond) structure with plain, unornamented wooden cornice and narrow stove chimneys. The south elevation of this house has been altered, eliminating the original entrances and now holding four first and second floor rectangular, double-hung windows with six-over-six lights decorated with flat sills and flat arched stretcher brick lintels.

The entrance facing west on Fair Street is located in a rear appendage on the north wall of the house, originally designed as a duplex.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Please see significant statements for Ho-215, Ho-216, Ho-221, Ho-223, Ho-224 and Ho-225, dealing with earlier mill houses in the Savage Historic District.

This house, though altered, is similar to those other nine two story brick houses located on Baltimore Street, between Church and Fair Streets, in the Savage Historic District, which contain two units each. This house has been altered to create a more pleasing facade with four first and second floor windows decorated with shutters, rather than two first floor windows and two entrances located one on each end.

These units do not appear on the Hopkins Atlas of 1878 and are believed to date from the first quarter of the twentieth century.






