Paul Perkins' Brick and Stone House


Facing west onto Old Columbia Pike, this 3-story stone house has large granite quoins, sills, and lintels, and is five bays wide, with two front entrances in the (l-r) 2nd and 4th bays. The northernmost three bays are covered by a 2-story porch with square posts and 2nd floor balustrade, whose shed roof connects to the building at the 3rd-floor level. The easternmost two 3rd-floor bays are built of 7-course brick, with one 6/6 casement window. This is probably an enlargement of the stone southern addition to the original 3-bay building. This southern addition has an entrance in its left bay and one 1/1 window in its right. The 2nd floor has one 1/1 window above the door.

There are two windows in the northernmost gable end, one centered on the first floor, and one on the attic level.

The rear facade has, in the main block, a central door and one 1/1 window to its right. The southern stone and brick addition has an entrance door and a 1/1 window on the 2nd floor.

A picket fence encloses the front yard.
