

Memories pf the 'homeplace' keep land in Howard's family for Ninety-Six (96) Years. This land and once upon a time a log cabin stood on this spot of ground adjacent to the Deep Run was a resting and stopping off place for Harriet Tubman where she could obtain water and food. Where she was safe, secure and protected, until she could reach the cemetery near freetown road. All free slaves lived on this tract of land called "Grecian Liege" owned by the Howard family for Ninety-Six (96) years. Three generations off Howards have lived in a log cabin that once stood on this tract of land. It is history of the Howard's family ancestor William Henry Howard slave of John Eager Howard's family in developing Howard County.

History of the Howard family.

In 1851 Howard District of Anne Arundel County, became Howard County, with Ellicott City as the County seat. Named for John Eager Howard of the Revolutionary war fame. John Eager Howard had two daughters and Six sons George Howard was the only son of John Eager Howard that lived in Howard County.

William Henry Howard was a slave of George Howard a large slaveholder. who owns slaves. William Henry Howard lived in a log bin near the Deep Run. William Henry Howard remained a slave until 56. In 1856 William Henry Howard was freed, a freedom certificate was issued by the clerk of the Circuit Court of Anne Arundel County.

William Henry Howard a free slave remained in the Elkridge area in a log cabin near the Deep Run. William Henry Howard a free slave married a free man Annie Harris. Annie Howard worked for Theodore Tubman who set aside a tract of land called "Grecian Liege where all free slaves lived. After Theodore Tubman died his wife Mary Tubman sold all that tract of land called "Grecian Liege" To James Trimble and his wife. Annie Howard continued to work for James and Mary Trimble and in 1898 James Trimble and Mary Trimble sold all that tract of land called "Grecian Liege" to Annie Howard of Howard <sup>County</sup> a free slave for Twenty-Seven dollars and Eighty-One cent (\$27.81).

This tract of land has been owned by the Howard family for Ninety-five (95) years. Three generations of Howards have lived on this tract of land. A building was named in honor of John Eager Howard, but no recognition was given to <sup>the</sup> slaves of John Eager Howard <sup>the</sup> family who helped to develop Howard County. This is the only land left to <sup>be</sup> given some recognition to the slave who played a part in the development of Howard County.
