'In the name of God Amen. I Isaac Spencer of Kent County in the State of Maryland...

"I devise and bequeath all my estate both real and personal either that I hold from my father that which I hold under my Brother William Spencer's Will or that which I have purchased myself to be equally divided among my children after deducting thirteen hundred dollars I have advanced to John Spencer and fifteen hundred I have advanced to Jervis Spencer."

I do hereby constitute my dear sons William A. Spencer and John Spencer trustees of my real estate with full powers to make such disposition thereof either by sale, lease or otherwise as they shall deem most advantageous towards paying my debts and to the interst of their brothers.

"Secondly I give and bequeath unto my loving son Isaac Spencer my dwelling plantation called Marrowbone, also part of a tract called Grantham, Smith's Point and Vienna, Mt. Harmon, Friendship and Saint Patricks Garden" - also a house and lots in New Market (Chesterville) and tract called Crumpton

...As to my real estate in land. I give and devise unto my son Isaac Spencer my Plantation whereon I live called "Marrowbone" being the quantity of four hundred acres, and also my plantation in said county near pricklepare Mill called Darby being about the quantity of four hundred acres of land to have and to hold said plantations and lands with the premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto my said son Isaac Spencer to his heirs for ever-




