4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This office is the first in a row of six significant nineteenth-century law offices. It is constructed of brick which is painted white. On the north side of the facade is the double door (four panels each) with dentil trim above and a transom of textured leaded glass. It has granite steps. To the south of the door is an expanse of three windows set in a panel of brick - the base of the panel is molded - there are stair sills, one over one sash and transoms like that above the door. The office has a flat roof and a wood modillion cornice. On each side of the door even with the transom is a plaque set in the brickwork of a bird.
