
This office is a two-bay, one-story building covered with clapboard. The door is on the north side of the facade and has no treatment except a two-pane transom, above which is a bracketed architrave. This same bracketed architrave is above the window which has three-panelled shutters painted black and six over six sash. This building also has a flat roof with bracketed cornice.


