The single-family dwelling at 21415 Berryman Road, located south of Rock Hall in Kent County, MD, is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

Built, in the last quarter of the 19th century, this two-story frame dwelling is set upon a pier (?) foundation with rusticated concrete block infill, is clad with asbestos shingles, and is covered with a gable roof with asphalt shingles and a brick end chimney. The facade is located in the gable end and consists of a replacement side door and a 2/2 window on the first story and a single replacement window on center of the second story. The side wall is two bays deep; a one-story rear addition with a gable roof extends off of the rear elevation. A single-story porch formerly extended across the front elevation.

The house is a representative example of late 19th century domestic building traditions and does not survive as a good example of its type. The dwelling lacks the architectural distinction and integrity necessary to qualify it for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.


