The single-family dwelling at 5364 Crosby Road, located southeast of Rock Hall in Kent County, MD. is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

This two-story, three-bay wood frame structure was built in the last quarter of the 19th century. The house is set upon a brick pier foundation with concrete block infill, has weatherboard walls, and is covered with a gable roof with a brick interior end chimney. A two-story ell extends towards the rear of the lot and is similarly covered with a gable roof. The facade is three bays wide with a side (replacement) entry door. Windows are the original 2/2 sash with what appears to be molded trim. The rear ell has three 2/2 windows on second floor and four 2/2 windows and a single door on the first floor.

The house is a representative example of late 19th century domestic building traditions in overall massing, building form and detail. The dwelling is not a distinctive example of its form, and due to replacement materials such as asphalt shingles and plywood door, lacks the architectural integrity necessary to qualify it for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.
