The single family dwelling at 5288 Eastern Neck Road near Langford Creek in Kent County, MD is not located in a National Register-listed or eligible historic district, nor does it qualify for individual listing.

The dwelling is a two-story, two-bay frame structure from the late 19th century. The house is set upon a low foundation and is covered with a gable roof with cornice returns in gable ends. The walls are clad with wood weatherboard and the windows fitted with 6/6 sash. A hipped roof and screened porch extends across the front facade, while a single-story rear ell covered with a gable roof is found at the rear. The house is typical of the rural domestic building of the late 19th century. It lacks the architectural integrity and distinctiveness necessary to qualify it for listing under Criterion C. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past.


