Based on the available information, Rock Hall is eligible for the Maryland Register of Historic Properties under Criteria A and C as an example of a late 19th and early 20th century maritime village in Kent County, Maryland. Located on the Chesapeake Bay at the mouth of Chester River, Rock Hall is the leading community in an area which has historically been the center of the seafood industry in Kent County. Rock Hall has long been noted for its maritime associations as a center of fishing and seafood industries and as a terminus for ferry travel. Rock Hall Historic District is an intact and largely residential community centered on a business district along Main Street. It is composed of mostly one and two story dwellings of the late nineteenth and early twentieth century, several churches, a school, and number of commercial buildings. Several mid- to late nineteenth century dwellings exhibit architectural features, including decorative cornerboards, which have been linked to the work of a local family of carpenters, the Judefinds.







Description Summary

Rock Hall Historic District is an intact and largely residential community centered on a business district along Main Street. It is composed of intact and cohesive streetscapes of mostly frame one and two story dwellings of mostly the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, plus two churches (Photographs C and L), a school, and an early motion picture hall (Photograph I), to name a few of the structures. Some of the dwellings (Photographs W, X, and Y) exhibit a pilaster-like decorative treatment of the cornerboards which may be a hallmark of a local family of carpenters, the Judefind family.

Description

Rock Hall, located on the Chesapeake Bay at the mouth of the Chester River, is part of a maritime area which is the center of the seafood industry in Kent County. This area, of which Rock Hall is the leading community, and whose many harbors provide havens for fishing, oyster and pleasure boats of all kinds, includes the rural sections of Piney Neck and Skinners Neck. These two necks are peninsulas that border Langford Bay, Chester River, Grays Inn Creek and Chesapeake Bay.

Rock Hall is a medium size village located southwest of Chestertown in Kent County. It has long been noted for its maritime associations as a center of the fishing and seafood industries, and as a terminus for ferry travel in past decades. It may have been named for Rock Hall Mansion, which was a landing of the Annapolis-Rock Hall Packet. This ferry between Annapolis and Rock Hall was an important link in the Eastern Post Road which led from New York to the Carolinas. There are records of George Washington, Tench Tilghman, Thomas Jefferson and James Madison passing through this area.

Separated from the landing by extensive areas of new housing outside of the corporate limits of Rock Hall is the intersection known as "Rock Hall Crossing", the intersection of Main Street (MD 445) and Sharp Street (MD 674) (Photograph C). Located at the Rock Hall Methodist Church, it is the center of both the business and historic districts of Rock Hall. Main Street is part of the first road created in Kent County in 1676. From the crossroads, the extension of Main Street leads to the Eastern Neck. From the crossroads to the east, Sharp Street (MD 674) leads to Chestertown. Thus, in the early colonial days, the area was a gateway to Kent County and the Northeast.

The actual founding of the town of Rock Hall took place 1707. The town may have absorbed the remnants of the disintegrating early village of New Yarmouth, which was the seat of government

and location of first courthouse in Kent County.

The historic district is composed of residential areas which cluster around the central business district. The commercial center of Rock Hall is the section of Main Street between Sharp Street (MD 674) and Rock Hall Avenue (MD 20). The residential areas include well tended properties along streets which retain integrity in their settings, and uniformity in set-backs and appearance, with good examples of gable front and flank frame cottages, bungalows, two-story frame "I" houses, (some with cross gables), and foursquare dwellings (see photographs F,G, and H). The residential areas include Main Street from Frederick Street on the north [with 5885 Main Street on the east side, and 5894 Main Street on the west side (see photograph A)], running south to Main Street's intersection with Catholic Street on the east side and 5608 Main Street on the west side.

The district includes the section between 21344 Catholic Avenue on the west to 21444 Catholic Avenue on the east and the section of Chesapeake Avenue from 21244 Chesapeake Avenue on the west to its junction with Main Street on the east (Photograph F). The district boundaries also encompass Rock Hall Avenue from Cottage Avenue (21142 Rock Hall Avenue and 21209 Rock Hall Avenue) on the west to the rear property lines of the houses on the east side of Main Street. Liberty Street between Rock Hall Avenue and Chesapeake Avenue is included, with the exception of a modern gas facility on the west side of Liberty Street. Finally, it includes Sharp Street from First Street on the west to its junction with Boundary Avenue on the west (Photographs H,M, and N).

The district boundaries include a significant grouping of nineteenth century commercial buildings. Some were built for commercial use, like Mrs. Leary's Store (Photograph D), built before 1877, and Durdin's Store (photograph J), built shortly thereafter, in the northeast and northwest quadrants of the intersection of Main and Sharp Streets, whereas a few further north toward Rock Hall Avenue (MD 20) which front Main Street, may have been built as residences and later converted to commercial use.

The town has two churches within the historic district. The Rock Hall Methodist Church, which dates to the mid-to-late nineteenth century (photograph C) is a good local example of the Gothic Revival style. It retains good integrity unlike the other, the Seventh Day Adventist Church (Photograph L) on Sharp Street, which originated as a wood building in 1892, but was veneered with brick in 1944, diminishing its integrity. The town also retains its original motion picture parlor, identified as the JR.

O.U.A.M. Hall (Photograph I) on the 1930 Sanborn Tax map. It is located in the southeast quadrant of Liberty and Sharp Streets intersection. The district also includes the Rock Hall High School, located on Sharp Street west of Liberty Street and built around 1915.

The only area in which there have been a number of visual intrusions in the form of buildings which do not contribute to the significance of the district is along Sharp Street between its intersections with Main Street and Boundary Avenue (Photographs M, N, and O). The Sargeant Preston Ashley American Legion Post #228 (Photograph R), Quality Screening (Photograph S), Ebb Tide Marine Service (Photograph T), Rock Hall Volunteer Fire Company (Photograph U), the concrete block structure at 21435 Sharp Street (Photograph P), and the pre-fabricated structure west of it (Photograph Q), and the Rock Hall Garage (Photograph K), constitute visual intrusions into a streetscape which is the location of numerous two or one story frame dwellings of modest scale with nearly identical set-backs from the edge of the road (Photographs M, N, and O).

The Rock Hall Historic District also includes dwellings and one original commercial property, Durdning's Store, which have a distinctive type of decorative treatment of the cornerboards. The rear, or east elevation of Durdning's Store, as opposed to the altered front elevation, have these cornerboards. Intact cornerboards exist on a grouping of late nineteenth century frame, two-story dwellings on the east side of Main Street from Catholic Street on the south to 5664 Main Street on the north, and a couple of structures on Liberty Street (5751 and 5791) and a few on Sharp Street etc (Photographs W, X, and Y).

These cornerboards, exhibiting a vertical incised pattern topped by an entablature beneath the roof cornice line, and with a variety of terminations at the top (mostly round headed) approximate a pilaster-like treatment. This use of an incised cornerboard may be part of the decorative treatment attributed to a local family of carpenters identified as the Judefind family in one unattributed reference (Kent County Guide, Kent County Bicentennial Committee, Chestertown, 1976, p. 40). Typical Judefind-built dwellings are described as "two-story frame dwellings, with applied decorated corner posts, doors with molded trim framed by window lights, attic dormers and comfortable front porches". The Judefinds may have been one family of carpenters among many who participated in a "building boom", described as a "persistent legend", due to the abundance of salvaged wood washed down from the area inundated by the Johnstown Flood in 1889. Mrs. Cornelius, a local inhabitant, relates that houses built of these timbers are confined to the Haven Creek area, not Rock Hall.

Despite the lack of substantiation, it is likely that some kind of building boom occurred in the late nineteenth century, as Rock Hall expanded appreciably between 1877 and 1895, with continued and sustained expansion continuing through to 1930. Of those buildings in Rock Hall with decorative cornerboards, few exhibit the transoms and sidelights, or the dormers, which are attributed by the unnamed source to the Judefind family of carpenters. As shown in Census Records, the Judefinds did not reside in Rock Hall prior to 1860, and were among many families of carpenters, according to local sources. John deeded a portion of his home place, (now destroyed and the location of a very large apartment complex south of MD 20 between Main St. on the west and Sharp Street on south and east) to the Seventh Day Adventist Church (L) in 1892 (SB 15/520). It is located at the intersection of Sharp Street and Judefind Road. The home was purchased by John Judefind from J.A. Hersch, identified as a carpenter, contractor and builder in the 1877 "Patron's List" for the Fifth District (Edesville). All of the Judefind descendants have died or left the Rock Hall area.

The Rock Hall Historic District is significant as an intact and largely residential Eastern Shore community centered on the business district located at the Rock Hall Crossroads of Main Street (MD 445) and Sharp Street (MD 674). It is composed of intact and cohesive streetscapes of frame, one and two-story, mostly nineteenth and early twentieth century examples of gable front or flank cottages, bungalows, "I" houses and foursquare dwellings.

This village is also significant for its association with the maritime environment, being close to the Chesapeake Bay and the home to numerous families who make their livelihoods from the harvesting of oysters, crabs, clams and fish. Rock Hall experienced a growing period during the latter half of the nineteenth century and early twentieth century, in part because the nearby harbor became a port for sailing packets from Baltimore and later from steamboat traffic across the Bay. This is the period of greatest historical significance. Lumbering, shipbuilding and farming were important industries, in addition to seafood gathering and commercial canning, which provided jobs for the local inhabitants and sparked sustained expansion through the years.




