The single-family dwelling at 22874 McKinleyville Road, located southeast of Rock Hall near Langford Creek in Kent County, MD, is not located in an historic district nor is it eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

Probably built in the late 19th or early 20th century, this two-story frame dwelling consists of two principal blocks, each two bays wide. Because the two blocks are clad with shingle siding it is not clear which may be older or if they were built together. In any case, the two blocks abut one another and are covered with gable roofs. The dwelling has a telescopic form formed by the two blocks, one of which is taller than the other, and an attached one-story wing with an enclosed sunroom. A one-story screen porch extends across the first story of the principal blocks. The dwelling has been altered by these additions as well as new siding, leaving only the 2/2 windows on the second story intact to their original state.

The dwelling represents a common building form from the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness and integrity necessary to qualify it for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.


