The single-family dwelling at 5002 Skinners Neck Road, located southeast of Rock Hall in Kent County, MD, is not located in an historic district nor does it retain sufficient integrity to qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

Based upon the photographs provided, it appears that this dwelling dates from the mid-19th century. It is a two-story, three-bay, frame structure with a steeply pitched gable roof with interior end chimneys and a boxed cornice. The facade features a central entry probably leading into a central-passage. Although this pre-Civil War dwelling retains its original massing, most of the building's materials have been replaced, including the original weatherboard walls, the roof covering, the door, windows and window trim and corner boards. The dwelling does not retain sufficient integrity to qualify for listing under Criterion C. Although no research has been conducted on this property, it is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.
