The property at 6115 Tolchester Road, Kent County is not located within an historic district. The building is a three bay, three story house with raised roof, shed dormers and central chimney. The gabled ends have wood shingles at the thrid floor level. The house displays signs of alteration and is covered in composite shingles of varying colors. The house has an asphalt roof. The integrity of the house has been compromised to a degree that it would not be eligible under architectural criteria for individual eligibility. It has no known significant associations.
