The single-family dwelling at 21903 Yerkey Road, located southeast of Rock Hall in Kent County, MD., is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

Built in the late 19th century, this dwelling is a one-room, two-story frame structure (one-up, one-down). The house is set upon a low foundation (not visible in photos), has weatherboard walls clad with asbestos shingles and aluminum siding in deteriorating condition, and is covered with a gable roof with an inside end brick chimney. A one-story enclosed porch extends across the front elevation obscuring the original first floor. The house is in poor condition cosmetically, but is apparently structurally sound.

The building is a common dwelling form for the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness and integrity to qualify it for listing on the Register under Criterion C. It is not known to have any associations with persons or events, and it thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.




