DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is a log structure, built in several sections. The one and one-half story east end is the oldest part; it is three bays, with a central doorway and flanking windows. The west end is two stories with a two-bay facade, the western one being a door. The chimney is between the two parts; it was once a free standing stack for the smaller eastern wing. Each section has a shed-roofed porch.

The frame kitchen wing extends north, part of it being two stories and part, one story. On the north end wall is a large, one story external stone fireplace with a brick stack.

Most of the windows are 6/6 double hung sash; on the east end wall, at the loft level, are two 9-light casement windows. Where windows have been replaced, they are 2/2 double hung sash.

The house is sheathed with clapboards; the foundation is stone.
