This was the site of an old farm complex that stood here until the early 1970's, when the present Fountain View Subdivision began. The old house was torn down, however a large frame barn remains. It is a bank barn that faces north and has painted-on "windows". The most unusual feature is that a wagon shed/corn crib is built onto the west gable-end.
