The Sheckles House is no longer standing.

Sometime after placement on the *Locational Atlas*, the Sheckles House (11/5) at 10017 Locust Drive was demolished. There is no record of a demolition permit from DPS, whose database goes back to 1987. The Sandy Spring Bank, which owns the property, is unable to determine if there was a structure on the property when they acquired it in 1987. The structure had been under ownership of the previous family from 1948. The house was a side gable structure with some Germanic influence, having dual front doors and a central chimney.


