DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is an L-shaped Victorian, 2-1/2 story frame farmhouse with tongue-and-groove siding. It sits on a stone foundation. The three center bays of the five bay main (east) facade are covered by a bracketed-cornice porch with bracketed square columns set on high bases. The central gable has an arched window. There are two internal chimneys about one third of the length of the house from either end wall. A bracketed-cornice ^{bay} window with square medallion decorative motifs has been added on the north end.

A log smokehouse with stone chinking stands behind the house. There is also a bankbarn with stone enclosed yard; it is of recent construction.
