DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is a 2-1/2 story brick Federal style house with large flush gable end chimney, laid up in Flemish bond on the main (north facade) and common bond on side and back walls. The entrance, with four light transom, is in the eastern bay of the three bay facade of the main house block. Flat brick arches carry the walls over the openings. The cornice consists of a row of angled bricks supporting a row of projecting headers.

On either end are two story, two bay wings, with similar detailing. Each wing has an end chimney; these chimneys and the ones on the main block have pointed arched hoods.

A porch with four columns and pediment has been added in front of the entrance bay.

In plan, the house has a side hall and double parlors. The stairs rise in three runs along the east wall of the hall.

Outbuildings include a log shed on a stone foundation, a board-and-batten and stone slaves' quarters with central chimney external to the stone section, served other stone and log buildings, and a bankbarn with three stone walls and one frame sidewall, with stone wall enclosed yard.

There is a stone mounting block in front of the house.
