DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story frame house stands on the north side of the junction of Old Big Woods Road and the new Big Woods Road. It faces south. In design, it resembles the other modestly scaled farm houses of the late 19th century. It has a three bay facade and is one bay in depth. The line of its gable roof is bisected by a cross gable pediment.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is another example of the type built by the second generation of Black landowners after the Civil War in communities throughout rural Maryland. According to oral informant, Florence Hallman from the Big Woods community, it had been the home of Gene Hackett. A complete title search back to Hackett ownership was not possible and the house could not be dated therefore by reference to deeds.

The following is its recent history. In 1964 the land was purchased by the current owners, Richard Calvin King from Claude Jarels and Ada Jarels (deed 3230/463). Previously, the land had been owned by John H. Dove and by William Knott (deeds, 3093/398; 422/185). However, none of those deeds gave reference to earlier owners and Gene Hackett was not listed in the grantee/grantor index.

Gene Hackett was probably related to Flave Hackett and other Hacketts of the Big Woods community.
