DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The frame house has a five bay main facade with a central doorway. Above the entrance, the central second story bay is semi-octagonal, with a semi-pyramidal roof; the front slope of the roof has a dormer window. The shed-roofed porch has octagonal doric columns with a pronounced entasis. Windows are 1/1 double hung sash. The end chimneys are internal. The gable ends have a returned cornice.

At present the siding is asbestos shingles.
