DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is a two story, framed structure, sitting on a stone foundation. The main (north) facade is three bays with a central doorway. On the east end is a one-story, frame kitchen addition. At the east end is a large stone chimney base with a concrete block stack.

The house is one room on the ground floor. At the west end is a fireplace. In the southeast corner, a boxed staircase leads to the second floor. There are two rooms opening off the hall, the partitions of which are lathed and plastered.

A staircase leads to the attic. The rafters, resting at the lower end on a nailer, are mortised, tenoned, and pegged at the ridge.

Interior doors are beaded boards. The chair rail on the ground floor is a board with beading on the upper and lower edges. Windows throughout are 6/6 double hung sash.

West of the house is a foundation for another room about the same size as the present building. The fireplace for this room has been closed in, but it utilized the same chimney as the existing room. Thus, the house was once a central chimney structure, built in two sections.
