Section 7.1

The Warfield House is located by taking Annapolis Rock Lane then continuing down the private road about 1.5 miles to the Wilson Warfield Farm, from here the house is located approximately .5 miles to the southwest. This house is noted on the 1979 Maryland Historic Sites Survey as the Warfield Farmhouse, but there is another fieldstone foundation site of a farmhouse located closer to the Wilson Warfield farm structures farther to the northeast. It would seem logical that foundation ruin is the site of the Wilson Warfield Farmhouse, and that this house is either another Warfield Farmhouse or another farm altogether. The appearance of the house suggests a building date from the early part of the twentieth century, with its clapboard siding, brick chimneys, and concrete foundation. It is deteriorating rapidly with the front porch fallen off of the house and most of the windows and doors missing, although the roof still seems to be intact. There are two deteriorated sheds on either side of the house, as well as, two fieldstone foundation shed ruins located to the southwest. Many old dirt roads pass by and intersect around the locations of these sheds, that are very near the Patuxent River.

Section 8.1

The Warfield House and the outbuildings on either side of the house appear to date from the first quarter of the twentieth century. The fieldstone foundations farther towards the west on the property appear to be of an earlier date, possibly the mid nineteenth century. The property served as a farm until the Department of Natural Resources acquired the land and the house was abandoned. There is a large area behind the property that was used as a garbage dump.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Wilson Warfield Farm is located on the north side of Annapolis Rock Lane, west of the Patuxent River. The main farmhouse is a two-story, gable-roofed, clapboard structure with a two-story, two-bay ell projecting from the rear (south) facade. The main (north) facade is three bays: a central doorway flanked by 6/6 double hung sashed window on the west and a secondary (perhaps business) entrance on the east on the first story and three symmetrically placed 6/6 windows on the second story. A shed roofed porch with simple wooden pier supports and brick bases extends across this facade.

Both gable ends (east, west facades) are defined by deep eaves with cornice returns and small 6/6 attic windows. The chimneys are located centrally in the main block and inside the gable end of the rear addition.

Various outbuildings including a one-story clapboard utility building and a one-story log smokehouse surround the main house.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The farm does not appear on the Martenet and Bond map of Montgomery County 1865 or the Hopkins Atlas of Montgomery County 1878. The complex was probably built circa 1900. In recent years the property was owned by Wilson Warfield

RECOMMENDATIONS

Presently the house is vacant and is scheduled for demolition by the Department of Natural Resources. With minimal structural and cosmetic rehabilitation, however, this property could easily be renovated for rental use. The house and surrounding outbuildings are well sited in a glen near the south bank of the Patuxent River and deserve simple restoration to their original function as a working farm rather than demolition by neglect.
