<p>The building is a two story structure of brick, stone and frame. The original brick section faced east with flush-gable chimneys on the north and south ends. A short brick wing extended to the west. To the west of this wing were two, one-story stone sections with frame second stories. These wings have heavy stone lintels. Between the main block and the wing, the space is filled in with a two story porch with square posts.</p> <p>The original main facade faced east. It was four bays. The lower floor has been covered over by a new wing. On the second floor it is four bays with flat arches over the windows. The cornice consists of four courses of bricks, the lower, a course of headers; the second, a row of sawtooth-like projecting bricks and a top two courses, projecting headers.</p>
