DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a pair of small, two-story frame houses of ca. 1900. The best of the two is a narrow, three-bay structure, that faces west on (old) Trundle Rd. This has a central door with simple transom, and 2/2 windows with shutters. There is a sharply-pointed, center gable here. The roof is metal, and there is a stove chimney within the south-end wall. Siding is German.
