DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is a two story, five bay, stone structure covered with plaster and painted white. It has internal chimneys. The main (south) facade has a center entrance with a small gabled porch. The doorway and transom light are set back from the wall plane, with the reveals panelled. The window frames consist of boarding with a bead along the inside edge, set back several inches from the wall plane.

The rear facade is divided into irregular bays. The entrance in the second bay from the west end is treated identically to the south entrance except that it is without transom. There is also a straight-gable porch.

On the end walls, the boxed cornice is returned into the gable ends. At the attic level small windows flank the stacks, quarter round ones on the east end and square headed ones on the west end.

In plan, the house has parlors flanking a center stair hall.

The R.T. Hilliard Farmhouse is a simply designed rural vernacular dwelling built of Seneca Sandstone, covered with plaster. The house was probably built by Robert T. Hilliard in 1873.¹ Robert Acquired the 170 acres on which his house rested from John W. Hilliard and others in March of 1873.² Robert T. Hilliard appears in Boyd's, History of Montgomery County, Maryland as a farmer. In 1883, Robert and his wife, Cecelia sold the farm to Edward P. Getzendanner for \$4,230.³ The farm remained in the Getzendanner family until 1919 when it was purchased by Eugene Jones and William P. Hunter.⁴ William P. Hunter moved here with his wife, Mattie and family in 1928 and resided here until their deaths in 1961 and 1955 respectively. Before their death's, however, the farm was conveyed to their son. John and his wife, Sadie in 1953.⁵ Then, in January of 1969, the property was sold to Stephan M and Ann C Jones.⁶ The farm, though, continues to be the residence of the Hunters.

According to Mr. Hunter, the barn on the property was constructed in 1911.


