DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The original house of the Hallman family burned years ago. According to oral informants in the Jerusalem community, Joe and Evelyn Harper and Cora and William Moore, the house stood on the south side of Jerusalem Church Road and was oriented to the north. It stood two stories in height, had a three bay facade, and had two rooms down and two up. Its design and general appearance approximated that of the Moore family house in Jerusalem, a photograph of which was copied as part of this survey.


JERUSALEM COMMUNITY,






