The house is a large frame structure, two stories high. The main block is square in plan with a three bay facade. The front entry is located at the north end and is surrounded with transom and sidelights. A porch with chamfered posts runs the length of the facade. The house has a hipped roof with a lantern protruding from the center. The windows are six over six lights, double hung sash. The cornice which extends out all around the house is supported by brackets. At the south elevation of the house are two large, corbelled, interior brick chimneys. The house has a somewhat lower, two story rear wing at the southern end. Also to the rear, at the northern end is another two story section with a porch facing the back yard. Along the northern elevation, adjoining the rear section, is a single story, shed roof addition with a central, exterior brick chimney block.

The kitchen section of the house is said to pre-date the rest of the house.
