DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a collection of three ruined or badly deteriorated buildings. The house has burned and only the foundation, a recent brick chimney, and a small part of one wall remain standing. The corner of the wall indicates a house of random stone with cut stone quoining blocks.

The more impressive of the two outbuildings is a deteriorating barn or shed built of random ashlar and accented by large quoining blocks. The facade is three bays wide with a segmentally arched center entrance. The arch is constructed of well cut voussoirs and keystone and is filled with a wooden panel to the wooden door lintel. Flanking the door and on the west gable end are small openings with heavy flat stone lintels and projecting sills. Horizontal louvers mortised into wooden frames remain in one of the window openings. The rear of the barn has a second arched entrance. The roof is of modern construction.

The third stone structure is a small dairy house built of smooth stone with large quoining blocks and a heavy lintel over the doorway on the west gabled end. Each of the other facades has a louvered window with flat stone lintels and sills. Unlike the barn, with wooden gable ends, the dairyhouse has stone gables with narrow vertical slots near the peak. The roof has completely disappeared.

To the east of the major complex is another house of no particular note.
