DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a long, one-story-with-attic, frame building with a gable-front facade. There is a central door, with a small loading platform, and one, 6/6 window. There is an old, gas pump here. Attached to the east side of the building is a large, low shed-roof addition, with large, sliding doors to accomodate loading of feed, etc. Both sections have vertical siding and tin roofs.

Across the street are several, late-19th/early-20th Century, frame country homes that make up this (Bucklodge) community.
