DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is one of the few remaining old houses along the Old Frederick Road. The house is built in two sections. The earliest part is a three-bay, log section that has been weatherboarded. This main (west) facade has a central doorway, and there is an internal chimney in the north end. The north gable end also has two small windows and looks quite similar in style to many of the area's early 19th Century homes. The siding is old and it appears that the house was probably always sheathed, and was meant to have the logs exposed. Although the style is early it is quite plain, with the exception of a box cornice along the front and rear. There is a two-bay addition joined to the south end that gives the present house a five-bay appearance.

Nearby are a turn-of-the-century bank barn and corn crib. All of the buildings are in a ruinous state.


