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DESCRIPTION: This is a one and a half story bungalow type house with 6/1 paned windows, a set out front facade block and recessed front entrance beneath a gabled front porch. The porch is supported by square elephantine columns with solid stucco between and egg and dart molding above. There is a small shed-roofed addition in the rear and a rear porch with one square wood column with square balusters. There is a 2/2 square dormer in the rear. Right elevation gables have returns. There is boxed cornice, plain frieze throughout and all windows have plain surrounds.
