DESCRIPTION: House has full basement with entrance on south side directly into basement. Front facade, first bay has triple 6/6 d.h.s windows; second bay has single 6/6 d.h.s window; 3ed bay door with five horizontal raised panels, no window.

West elevation-right side-sun porch, enclosed with four-pane windows. Supported by brick piers with lattice panels in checkerboard pattern. Porch possibly original, enclosed at later date. There is clapboard solid railing and plain side by side square supports for roof at each end.

Rear elevation-Center dormer with shed roof with casement window with plain surround. Main floor has 6/6 d.h.s. windows in first and third bays, and 1/1 d.h.s. in second bay. Basement has six-light door and 9-light casement window in third bay.

East elevation-first bay has 6/6 d.h.s. window, second bay door with six lights. All windows and doors have plain surrounds.
