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DESCRIPTION: Facade-porch recessed in 1st, 2nd, 3rd bay; 4th bay projects; 5th bay addition, same siding, one 6/6 d.h.s. There are exposed rafters on the porch which is supported by square slender columns with square plain balusters. There is a 2/2 d.h.s. window on either side of the door. Two chimneys, one center roof line just left of second bay, other at rear of 4th bay gable. Left elevation-small shed addition at rear gable roof line. This structure was possibly a summer house.
