DESCRIPTION: This building has been greatly modified. Roof has exposed rounded eaves and original pressed tin. Facade has wrap-around porch which has been enclosed with small paned windows and double front door added. Second floor has one 2/2 window in each of two bays. Attic has single window in center of gable converted to air vent. Right side has a two-storey bay with a 2/2 window in each bay. Rear has two additions. One room appears to have been added close to the time of construction with 2/2 windows and some original German siding visible. Structure is covered in composition material imitating ashlar.
