DESCRIPTION: Side-hall plan, two rooms deep. 1st floor-front full porch with half-hip roof, exposed porch rafters, two bays wide. Left bay has side-by-side window, 1/1 d.h.s. Door is in right bay, appears to be original with decorative molding at bottom of panel and one-light transom. Three support columns on porch, square at top and bottom with turned centers.

2nd floor-two windows, 2/2, plain moldings.

3rd floor-one center window with two louvered shutters, imbricated pattern shingles. Plain water table between 2nd floor and attic with ogee molding. Eaves-projecting exposed rafters, roof trim projecting plain, rafters rounded.

Left-symmetrical two bays with small basement window and 2/2 windows 1st & 2nd floors.

Rear-Attic and 2nd storey same as front. First floor has back porch with offset center door to kitchen. Flooring and columns replaced, but remnants of roof appear original, windows in each bay. Bulkhead entrance through porch floor.

Right-3-light casement window in middle bay, d.h.s. in 1st and 2nd bays.
