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DESCRIPTION: Porch extends the full width of the facade and is supported by four round columns. There is a double transom over the front door. The lower half of the house is clapboard and the top half is sawtooth shingles. There is a boxed cornice with a frieze. The gable has a return and a narrow 1/1 window. There are wide window surrounds. The left elevation has a bay window with a hipped roof. Rear elevation has a now-enclosed porch. Right elevation has door with five panels and oval doorknob. This house is almost identical to 12 George.
