Left elevation-eaves projecting, no rafters exposed, long window on second storey. Rear elevation-flat portion of roof, exposed rafters, offset plain gable, enclosed porch half stucco covered, half asphalt. Right elevation-exposed rafters, gable. The two gables back up to each other.
