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DESCRIPTION: This is a typical Gaithersburg Style house that has been modified by the addition of stucco to its wood siding. There is symmetrical fenestration throughout, a boxed cornice with crown molding with frieze only under the corners in the facade. On the left elevation rear bay there is a two-storey bay window area. The left gable end has projecting overhang, front gable has small window. The front porch wraps to the left. There is a rear enclosed two-storey shed-roofed addition covered in aluminum siding.
