DESCRIPTION: The front porch is supported by seven plain round wood columns and plain square wood balusters and molded handrail. The main door has long narrow side lights in upper half and raised wood panel below. There is symmetrical fenestration and a gable with return, boxed cornice with molded fascia, plain frieze.

The right elevation has a two-storey bay window area. Gable end has small square single-light window with plain surround. Rear elevation has various additions. There is an addition to the left elevation which is used as a waiting room and hallway to the doctor's office.
