DESCRIPTION: The full width front porch is supported by four chamfered turned posts each having a decorative corner bracket. The porch roof is covered with raised seam tin and has a boxed cornice and plain frieze. The main door has a single light in the upper half, with four raised panels in the lower half. There is a recessed panel in the transom above and a plain common wood surround. There are side-by-side d.h.s. 1/1 windows in the second bay and a single window in the second storey. The gable front has a plain frieze, boxed cornice with return and a 1/1 d.h.s. window surrounded by staggered butt wood shingled in a scallop design.

Left elevation: symmetrical fenestration and a side door entrance on the rear porch addition. The rear porch addition is covered half in siding found on the rest of house and half in board and batten.

Right elevation: two-storey bay window located in second bay with gable roof. There is a single 1/1 window in each bay.
