DESCRIPTION: There is a full width front porch supported by double pillar on brick piers. There are vertical sidelights on either side of the main door. There is a wide overhang with boxed cornice and frieze and architrave molding. The windows are 4/1 with some on the rear elevation being 10/1. There are dormers in the front roofline with hipped roofs, two windows with four panes each. The rear elevation has a full width porch that wraps to the left side of the house. There are exposed rafters. The porch is inset with the second storey being part of the main block of the house.
